New Services

Dedham Therapy Farm now offers ASDAN short courses to young people between the ages of 11 – 18. The Courses are flexible, portfolio-based programmes designed to accredit up to 60 hours of activity and skills development across a range of topics and curriculum areas. We are starting with animal care but will soon also be offering gardening and PSHE. Because they are multi-level, the focus is on completing challenges and skills development according to individual ability.

ASDAN short courses are a stepping stone for the young person to progress onto other learning such as further ASDAN courses or college. ASDAN's courses have a proven track record in developing character traits in young people. Resilience, self-regulation, and emotional and social skills can play an important role in enabling young people to achieve positive health, education, employment, and other outcomes.

Farm Assistants can access short course on a one to one or group basis.
